HAURAKI RAIL TRAIL

- Sight-seeing on a bike!
- The 160km trail is one of the easiest Great Rides in New Zealand, Grade One, all fitness levels.
- From the Shorebird Coast through lush farmlands to the gold secrets of the Karangahake Gorge.
- Multiday rides – freedom, fully supported, baggage transfer and shuttle.


COASTAL WALKWAY

- Track between Fletcher and Stony Bays, at the very top of The Coromandel peninsula.
- Great views of the coastline and offshore islands.
- The best way to experience this walk is an out-and-back hike, stopping for lunch at Poley Bay (and a swim) .
- Take a guided tour from Coromandel Town with Hike and Bike Coromandel, and add on an e-bike ride back down the scenic west coast to Colville
- Road is not suitable for hire cars and campers.

THE PINNACLES

- **A Must Do**
- The summit provides views to both the east and west coast
- 80-bed DOC hut must be booked in advance
- Adventure Valley - hiking, biking, abseiling and canyoning with Canyonz
