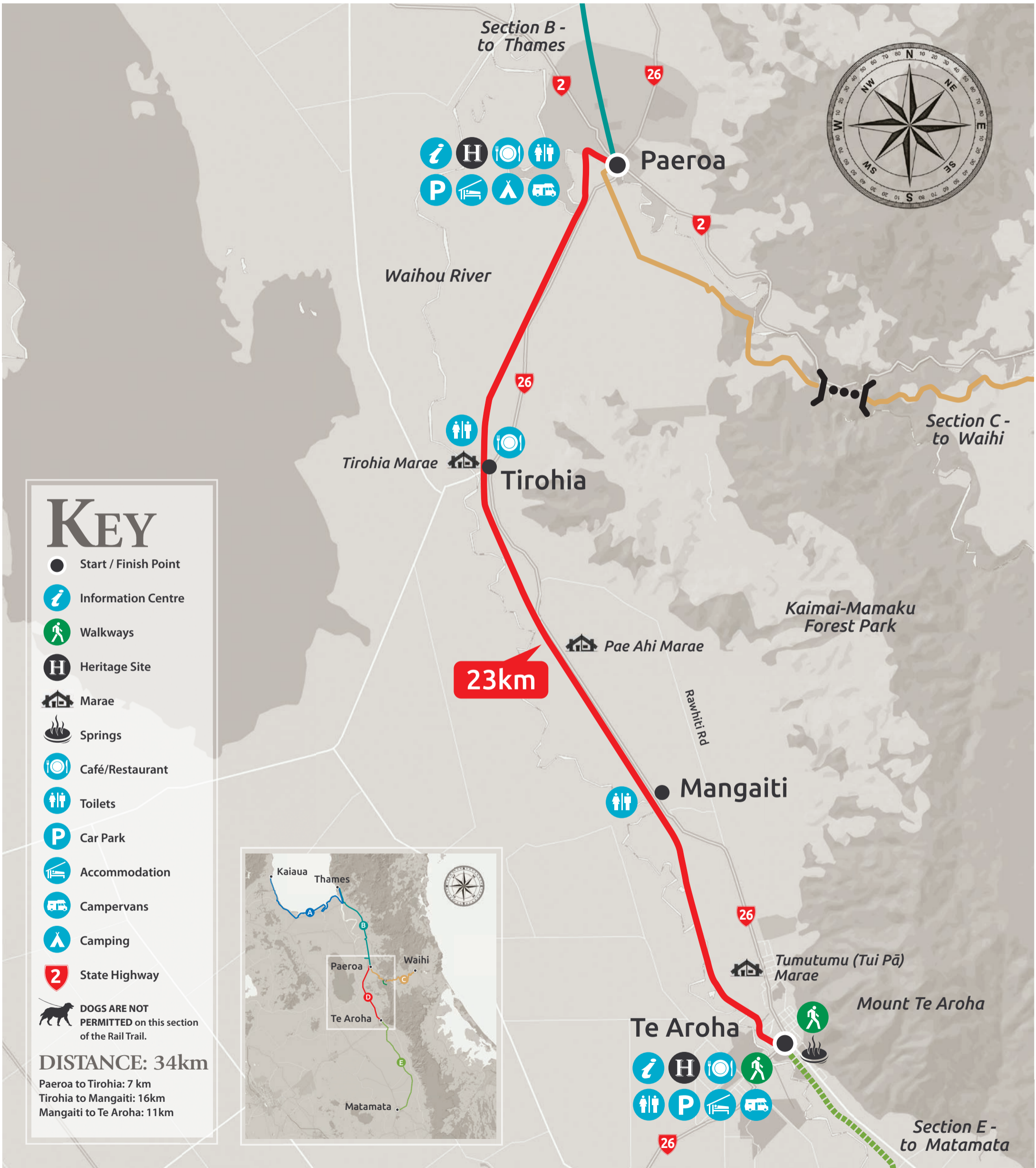
















Paeroa to Te Aroha

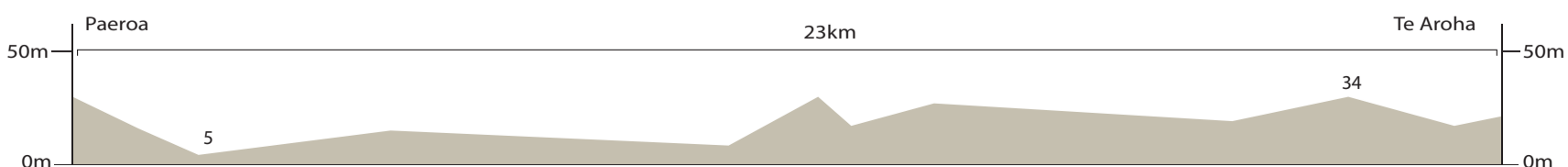
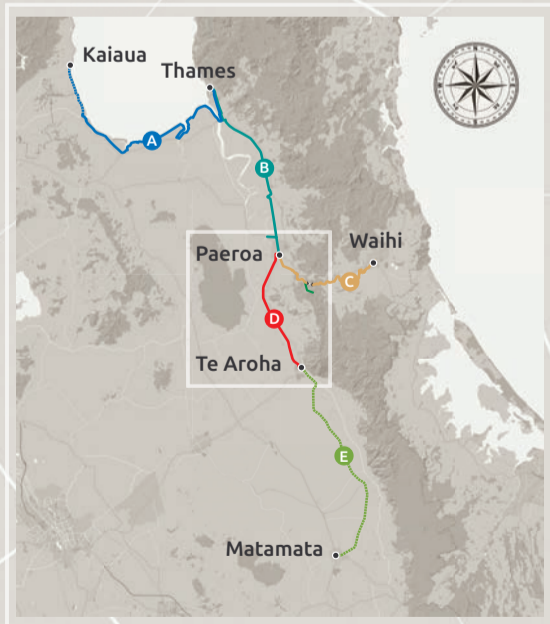
