Ferry Landing Wharf History

Ferry Landing stone steps and wharf was the first hand hewn wharf in Australasia, being built in the early 1830's for Gordon Browne who ran a water driven saw mill with Ranulph Dacre. The stone blocks, cut by Maori labourers, were taken from the adjacent bank. Many blocks are 1.8m long, 1.2m wide and 0.6m thick.
